This letter contains information about the **2021 Online Scholarship Testing Day**.

Due to the impact and restrictions set by the highly infection Coronavirus COVID19 we are chartering through unfamiliar processes.

The 2021 Scholarship Test will be an Online Test and our scholarship testing partners Edutest will conduct it on **Saturday, 5 September 2020 at 10.00 am.**

Candidates will receive correspondence with reference to the login ID and password via Edutest, closer to the test date.

Your child/ren will undertake a set of four tests

- a. Verbal Reasoning
- b. Numerical Reasoning
- c. Reading Comprehension
- d. Mathematics

Each test is timed for 30 minutes and it consists of 40 -60 questions. according to the year level of the student and also the individual test component

Your child/ren must have a fully charged device specifications are listed by Edutest.

Your child/ren and you will need to fill out the **ONLINE@HOME TESTING DECLARATION OF AUTHENTICITY** form and return it to Edutest before 5 pm on the test day.

You must confirm your child/ren do not have any of their books, papers, measuring or calculating instruments of any kind, including calculator watches, mobile device and any smart devices.

A form of identification will be required.

Acceptable forms of identification are:

- Student ID card (issued by your school )
- Current student travel card
- Passport (recent)
- Current library card (with photo).

Note: Only one form of identification is sufficient

There is an allowance of 15 minutes to login from the testing time any child/ren attending the test after this time will not be permitted. Latecomers will not be permitted to sit the examination.

Parents will not be able to accompany their child/ren in the allocated testing room. We wish your child/ren all the best for the examination period and look forward to reviewing the results.
